# 'God Bless You' ... Are You Sure? Know the Real Jesus Luke 6:20-26 ESV

# Those who are blessed of God live w/certain attitudes:

1) A continuous and humbling **self-evaluation** 

### The blessing:

God's favor - Christ' presence, power, peace and joy now.

<sup>20</sup>And He (Jesus) lifted up his eyes on His disciples, and said: Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God.

**2)** A continuous hunger to live a righteous <u>life</u> in <u>honor</u> of God

### The blessing:

An inner contentment of the fullness of what's to come

<sup>21</sup>Blessed are you who are hungry now, for you shall be satisfied...

**3)** A grieving brokenness over **personal** & **societal** sin.

#### The blessing:

A joyful expectation of dwelling with God

<sup>21</sup>...Blessed are you who weep now, for you shall laugh.

**4)** A Christ **pleasing** perspective when making **choices**.

#### The blessing:

Hated, excluded, reviled & slandered - just like the prophets

<sup>22</sup>Blessed are you when people hate you and when they exclude you and revile you and spurn your name as evil, on account of the Son of Man! <sup>23</sup>Rejoice in that day, and leap for joy, for behold, your reward is great in heaven; for so their fathers did to the prophets.

# Those who ignore Christ may also have certain attitudes:

**1)** They have a certain <u>self</u> righteousness: A belief that this life is all there is and they have it covered.

The woe:

This is the best it gets for them: the future lacks the favor of God and will be disastrous

<sup>24</sup>But woe to you who are rich, for you have received your consolation.

## 2) Live for self-satisfaction.

The woe: in great want later.

<sup>25</sup>Woe to you who are full now, for you shall be hungry.

3) <u>Laugh</u> off personal/societal sin.

The woe: never ending torment.

<sup>25</sup>...Woe to you who laugh now, for you shall mourn and weep.

**4)** Living a compromising <u>false faith</u> in order to please others and to be <u>popular</u> amongst others.

### The woe:

A self deceived, thus deceiving of others false faith.

<sup>26</sup>Woe to you, when all people speak well of you, for so their fathers did to the false prophets
