Dangers of Drifting

Jesus is Better – So Persevere
Hebrews 2:1-4 ESV

¹Therefore we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away from it. ²For since the message declared by angels proved to be reliable, and every transgression or disobedience received a just retribution, ³how shall we escape if we neglect such a great salvation? It was declared at first by the Lord, and it was attested to us by those who heard, ⁴while God also bore witness by signs and wonders and various miracles and by gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to His will.

1. Drifting's c _____ vs1

Lack of close attention to God's Word regarding Jesus.
>Usually guided by currents of: familiarity, busyness, laziness, cultural conformity, moral compromise, or a false profession
(see Matthew 7:21-25; 13:19-23; 2 Corinthians 13:5).

2. Drifting's c _____ (1 Cor. 3:11-15; 2 Cor. 5:9-11) vs2-3^a

- Spiritual dullness
- Stuck
- Shattered
- Shipwrecked (see Luke 6:46-49)

3. Drifting's c _____ of c _____ vs3^{b-4}

Stop neglecting the **greatness of Gods salvation** – instead reflect on **'it'** and **share** it with others – It is:
a. Declared by Jesus Himself (*reflect on the gospels*)
b. Confirmed by the apostles (*reflect on the letters*)
c. Verified by supernatural works (*reflect on Acts*)

Solution:

Get back on course – reflect on 1 chapter of 'each' everyday
