Consider Jesus

Jesus is Better – So Persevere
Hebrews 3:1-6 ESV

¹Therefore, holy brothers, you who share in a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the apostle and high priest of our confession, ²who was faithful to Him who appointed Him, just as Moses also was faithful in all God's house. ³For Jesus has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses —as much more glory as the builder of a house has more honor than the house itself. ⁴(For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God.) ⁵Now Moses was faithful in all God's house as a servant, to testify to the things that were to be spoken later, ⁶but Christ is faithful over God's house as a son. And we are His house, if indeed we hold fast our confidence and our boasting in our hope.

Why?

1) He made sure of our heavenly **calling** into a **holy** family. **v1a**

2) He made sure of our **confession**: I'm forgiven because Jesus, God's faithful Son served as my mediator. **v1b-6a**

3) He gives us assurance and **confidence** that we are a part of His household (spiritual) as we persevere. **v6b**
