The Commendable Life of Faith

(Hebrews 11:1-7 ESV)

¹Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. ²For by it the people of old received their **commendation**. ³By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible.

⁴By faith Abel offered to God a more acceptable sacrifice than Cain, through which he was **commended** as righteous, God c**ommending** him by accepting his gifts. And through his faith, though he died, he still speaks.

⁵By faith Enoch was taken up so that he should not see death, and he was not found, because God had taken him. Now before he was taken he was **commended** as having pleased God. ⁶And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who seek Him.

⁷By faith Noah, being warned by God concerning events as yet unseen, in reverent fear constructed an ark for the saving of his household. By this he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith.

Faith is a present & continuing reality for a biblical God follower – a way of life as one trusts in & relies on Him:

- 1. It is accompanied by certain: vs 1-3, 6
 - a) Assurances
 - **b)** Convictions
 - c) Commendations
 - **d)** Rewards

Examples to learn from:

- **1)** Like Abel–Let's offer ourselves to God w/o holding back. (even when less seems "good enough" & is more than others give)
- 2) Like Enoch-Let's depend on God as we influence family.
- 3) Like Noah-Let's obey God no matter how crazy or the cost.
