¹⁸Pray for us, for we are sure that we have a clear conscience, desiring to act honorably in all things. ¹⁹I urge you the more earnestly to do this in order that I may be restored to you the sooner. ²⁰Now may the God of peace who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great shepherd of the sheep, by the blood of the eternal covenant, ²¹**equip you** (*mend, make ready, set in place, heal, restore, infuse ability, prepare for a purpose*) **with everything good** that you may **do His will**, working in us that which is **pleasing** in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

²²I appeal to you, brothers, bear with my word of exhortation, for I have written to you briefly. ²³You should know that our brother Timothy has been released, with whom I shall see you if he comes soon. ²⁴Greet all your leaders and all the saints. Those who come from Italy send you greetings. ²⁵Grace be with all of you.

- 1) Are continually praying for one another: v18-19**
 - a) To act honorably with a clear conscience** (*1 Cor. 13:7*)
 - b) So relationships may be restored** (*Romans 12:16b-18*)

- 2) Are counting on the **peace** of God for our wellbeing: v20**
 - a) Paid** for by Jesus' death & resurrection (*1Pet 1:3-4; 18-19*)
 - b) Promised** by our Shepherd, Jesus (*John 10:14-15; 27-28; 16:33*)

- 3) Are connecting to the **power** of God - yielded to Jesus v21**
 - a) To do His good will** (*Phil 2:11-12*)
 - b) To be pleasing** Him by producing "spiritual" fruit (*John 15:4-5; 7-9*)
