





Wise Words (part 1)

Wisdom to Live By – a study through Proverbs

18:21a Death and life are in the power of the tongue.

James 3:10 From the same mouth come blessing and cursing.

My brothers and sisters, these things ought not to be so.

AVOID WORDS THAT WOUND & BRING DEATH:

1. Avoid deceit

- 26:28 A lying tongue hates its victims, and a flattering mouth works ruin.
- 20:17 Bread gained by deceit is sweet to a man, but afterward his mouth will be full of gravel.
- 19:5 A false witness will not go unpunished, and he who breathes out lies will not escape.

2. Avoid gossip

- 16:28 A dishonest man spreads strife, and a whisperer separates close friends.
- 18:8 Words of a whisperer are like delicious morsels; they go down into the inner parts of the body.
- 26:20 For lack of wood the fire goes out, and where there is no whisperer, quarreling ceases.

ADOPT WORDS THAT HEAL & BREATHE LIFE:

1. Speak graciously

- 15:4 A gentle answer is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit.
- 12:18 There is one whose rash words are like sword thrusts, but the tongue of the wise brings healing.
- 16:24 Gracious words are like a honeycomb, sweetness to the soul and health to the body.

2. Speak God-honoring truth

- 14:25 A truthful witness saves lives, but one who breathes out lies is deceitful.
- 24:26 Whoever gives an honest answer kisses the lips.
- 12:19 Truthful lips endure forever, but a lying tongue is but for a moment.
