Easter Means a Second Chance

Luke 24:1-12; Mark 16:7

¹But on the first day of the week, at early dawn, they went to the tomb, taking the spices they had prepared. ²And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, ³but when they went in they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. 4While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel. ⁵And as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them: Why do you seek the living among the dead? ⁶He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, ⁷that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise ("but go, tell His disciples and Peter..." Mark 16:7). 8And they remembered His words, ⁹and returning from the tomb they told all these things to the eleven and to all the rest. 10 Now it was Mary Magdalene and Joanna and Mary the mother of James and the other women with them who told these things to the apostles, ¹¹but these words seemed to them an idle tale, and they did not believe them. ¹²But Peter rose and ran to the tomb, stooping and looking in, he saw the linen cloths by themselves; and he went home marveling at what had happened.

1. The 2nd chance is **pressing** – because everyone fails **royally**.

2. The 2nd chance is **possible** – because Jesus died and **rose**.

3. The 2nd chance is <u>personal</u> – each one must believe and run to Jesus – receive Him, the resurrected Lord & Savior.
