Disharmony happens often – restoration not so much:

1) Time is of the essence. v2a

2) Two are needed at the table of reconciliation. v2b

3) Turning to and seeking agreement in Christ is key. v2c

>1 Peter 3:8-9, 18

>Romans 12:16-18

4) Three are better than 2 - one serves as mediator. v3a

>1 Timothy 2:3-6

5) Testimonies are at stake (*personal, church, Jesus*). 3b
