

Disharmony happens often – restoration not so much:

1)<u>Time</u> is of the essence. v2a

2) <u>Two</u> are needed at the table of <u>reconciliation</u>. v2b

3) <u>Turning</u> to and seeking agreement in Christ is <u>key</u>. v2c >1 Peter 3:8-9, 18 >Romans 12:16-18

4) Three are better than 2 - one serves as mediator. v3a >1 Timothy 2:3-6

5) Testimonies are at stake (personal, church, Jesus). **3b**
