75 Days in the Psalms – Psalm 1 (ESV)

- ¹ Blessed is the man
who walks not in the counsel of the wicked,
nor stands in the way of sinners,
nor sits in the seat of scoffers;
- ² but his delight is in the law of the LORD,
and on his law he meditates day and night.
- ³ He is **like a tree**
planted by streams of water
that yields its fruit in its season,
and its leaf does not wither.
In all that he does, he prospers.
- ⁴ The wicked are not so,
but are **like chaff** that the wind drives away.
- ⁵ Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment,
nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous;
- ⁶ for the LORD knows *the way of the righteous*,
but *the way of the wicked* will perish.
