The Challenge with Nearsightedness

Psalm 73 (ESV)

¹Truly God is good to Israel, to those who are pure in heart. ²But as for me, my feet had **almost stumbled**, my steps had nearly slipped.

³For I was **envious** of the arrogant when I saw the prosperity of the wicked.

⁴For they have no pangs until death; their bodies are fat and sleek. ⁵They are not in trouble as others are; they are not stricken like the rest of mankind.

⁶Therefore pride is their necklace; violence covers them as a garment.

⁷Their eyes swell out through fatness; their hearts overflow with follies.

⁸They scoff and speak with malice; loftily they threaten oppression. ⁹They set their mouths against the heavens, and their tongue

struts through the earth. ¹⁰Therefore his people turn back to them, and find no fault in them.

¹¹And they say, "How can God know? Is there knowledge in the Most High?"

¹²Behold, these are the wicked; always at ease, they increase in

¹³All **in vain have I kept my heart clean** and washed my hands in innocence.

¹⁴For all the day long I have been stricken and rebuked every morning.

¹⁵If I had said, "I will speak thus," I would have betrayed the generation of your children.

¹⁶But when I thought how to understand this, it seemed to me a wearisome task,

¹⁷until I went into the sanctuary of God; then I discerned their end. ¹⁸Truly **you** set them in slippery places; **you** make them fall to ruin.

¹⁹How they are destroyed in a moment, swept away utterly by terrors!

²⁰Like a dream when one awakes, O Lord, when **you** rouse yourself, **you** despise them as phantoms.

²¹When my soul was embittered, when I was pricked in heart,

²²I was brutish and ignorant; I was like a beast toward you.

²³Never<u>theless</u>, I am continually with <u>you</u>; <u>you</u> hold my right hand. ²⁴You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will receive me to glory.

²⁵Whom have I in heaven but **you**? And there is nothing on earth that I desire besides you.

²⁶My flesh and my heart may fail, **but God** is the strength of my heart and my portion forever.

²⁷For behold, those who are far from you shall perish; you put an end to everyone who is unfaithful to you.

²⁸But for me it is **good to be near God**; I have made the Lord God my refuge, that I may tell of all your works.

Focusing on others' lives instead of God's life for/in us:

1) Can lead to a disturbing problem.

2) Can lead to a distorted perspective.

3) Can lead to a **debilitating** pity (self). vs13-16
