¹ O LORD, God of my salvation, I cry out day and night before you. ² Let my prayer come before you; incline your ear to my cry! ³ For my soul is full of troubles, and my life draws near to Sheol. ⁴ I am counted among those who go down to the pit; I am a man who has no strength, ⁵ like one set loose among the dead, like the slain that lie in the grave, like those whom you remember no more, for they are cut off from your hand. ⁶ You have put me in the depths of the pit, in the regions dark and deep. ⁷ Your wrath lies heavy upon me, and you overwhelm me with all your waves. Selah ⁸ You have caused my companions to shun me;

you have made me a horror to them. I am shut in so that I cannot escape;

⁹ my eye grows dim through sorrow.

Every day I call upon you, O LORD; I spread out my hands to you.

¹⁰ Do you work wonders for the dead? Do the departed rise up to praise you? Selah

- ¹¹ Is your steadfast love declared in the grave, or your faithfulness in Abaddon?
- ¹² Are your wonders known in the darkness, or your righteousness in the land of forgetfulness?

¹³ But I, O LORD, cry to you; in the morning my prayer comes before you.

- ¹⁴ O LORD, why do you cast my soul away? Why do you hide your face from me?
- ¹⁵ Afflicted and close to death from my youth up, I suffer your terrors; I am helpless.
- ¹⁶ Your wrath has swept over me; your dreadful assaults destroy me.
- ¹⁷ They surround me like a flood all day long; they close in on me together.
- ¹⁸ You have caused my beloved and my friend to shun me; my companions have become darkness.
