

he remembers that we are dust.

<sup>15</sup> As for man, his days are like grass; he flourishes like a flower of the field;

<sup>16</sup> for the wind passes over it, and it is gone, and its place knows it no more.

 $^{\rm 17}$  But the steadfast love of the LORD is from everlasting to

everlasting on those who fear him, and his righteousness to children's children,

<sup>18</sup> to those who keep his covenant and remember to do his commandments.

<sup>19</sup> The LORD has established his throne in the heavens, and his kingdom rules over all.

<sup>20</sup> Bless the LORD, O you his angels, you mighty ones who do his word, obeying the voice of his word!

 <sup>21</sup> Bless the LORD, all his hosts, his ministers, who do his will!
 <sup>22</sup> Bless the LORD, all his works,

in all places of his dominion.
