¹ The saying is trustworthy: If anyone <u>aspires</u> to the office of overseer, he desires a noble task.

² Therefore an overseer must be <u>above reproach</u>, the husband of one wife, sober-minded, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, <u>able to teach</u>, ³ not a drunkard, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. ⁴ <u>He must manage his own household well</u>, with all dignity keeping his children submissive, ⁵ for if someone does not know how to manage his own household, how will he care for God's church? ⁶ He must not be a recent convert, or he may become puffed up with conceit and fall into the condemnation of the devil. ⁷ Moreover, he must be well thought of by outsiders, so that he may not fall into disgrace, into a snare of the devil."
