**A Prayer for the New Year**

Psalm 90:1-17 (ESV)

- <sup>1</sup> **Lord**, you have been our dwelling place in all generations.
- <sup>2</sup> Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.
- <sup>3</sup> You return man to dust and say, “Return, O children of man!”
- <sup>4</sup> For a thousand years in your sight are but as yesterday when it is past, or as a watch in the night.
- <sup>5</sup> You sweep them away as with a flood; they are like a dream, like grass that is renewed in the morning:
- <sup>6</sup> in the morning it flourishes and is renewed; in the evening it fades and withers.
- <sup>7</sup> For we are brought to an end by your anger; by your wrath we are dismayed.
- <sup>8</sup> You have set our iniquities before you, our secret sins in the light of your presence.
- <sup>9</sup> For all our days pass away under your wrath; we bring our years to an end like a sigh.
- <sup>10</sup> The years of our life are seventy, or even by reason of strength eighty; yet their span is but toil and trouble; they are soon gone, and we fly away.
- <sup>11</sup> Who considers the power of your anger, and your wrath according to the fear of you?
- <sup>12</sup> **So teach us to number our days** that we may get a heart of wisdom.
- <sup>13</sup> Return, O LORD! How long?  
**Have pity on your servants!**
- <sup>14</sup> Satisfy us in the morning with your steadfast love, that we may rejoice and be glad all our days.
- <sup>15</sup> Make us glad for as many days as you have afflicted us, and for as many years as we have seen evil.
- <sup>16</sup> Let your work be shown to your servants, and your glorious power to their children.
- <sup>17</sup> Let the favor of the Lord our God be upon us, and establish the work of our hands upon us; yes, establish the work of our hands!
